Additional Instructions and Information

When homeowners desire to make changes or alterations to their property, e.g., patio/screen room additions, changes to the existing landscape plantings, addition of landscape curbing, driveway, sidewalk or patio pavers, etc., a completed Architectural Change Request form (ACR) must be submitted to the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) for approval. A copy of the homeowner's property survey, marked-up to show the location of desired changes must also be submitted along with a completed Work Order request form for an irrigation survey.

Irrigation surveys are performed by the Association's irrigation contractor, at no charge to the homeowner. They will locate and flag sprinkler heads and irrigation water lines in close proximity to areas identified for changes on the submitted property survey copy. The purpose of the irrigation survey is to help avoid damage to the irrigation system during homeowner-proposed project work, which would have to be repaired at homeowner expense.

If modification of the existing irrigation system is required to accommodate the homeowner's project, the irrigation contractor will provide a cost estimate to the homeowner. The homeowner is responsible for all modification costs.
